As a resident and voter in the Vale of Glamorgan, I call on you to discharge your responsibilities as our elected First Minister, which include:

- a duty and an obligation to protect the Health and Well-being of Future Generations, under the Welsh Government's Well-being of Future Generations (Wales) Act 2015
- to have full consideration of the Precautionary Principle, also known as the UN Rio Declaration of 1992.
- To direct Natural Resources Wales to refuse the following environmental permit application:
